ABOUT MONA LOÍZA

La Mona Loíza is a boutique hospitality concept, a premium guest house and extended stay property, consisting of 34 units of various room types, from studio type hotel bedrooms to fully equipped three-bedroom apartments with kitchens. Surrounded by open, breezy common areas defined by Spanish colorful tiles reflecting the neighborhood's architectural heritage.

La Mona Loíza anchors the entrance of Condado, the modern, beach going tourist core of San Juan and the start of Calle Loíza, an entrepreneurial boulevard enveloping pedestrians in a melange of cultural heat mixing Puerto Rican, afro-Caribbean, Latin American, and European influences across food, drink, art, dance, and community outreach.

Guests find a familiar comfort of home and flexibility of stay not usually afforded by traditional accommodations with the sophistication and luxury of an independent hotelier dedicated to making every guest feels the enchanted beauty that is the island of Puerto Rico. The Atlantic beach front is five minutes walking distance from the property whilst the Santurce arts district and farmers market turned outdoor, dance and bar stall maze Placita is but a brief Uber away.

WHO IS LA MONA LOIZA?

Upon arriving at La Mona Loiza, you will be greeted by a majestic and engrossingly colorful ceramic tile mural of a fierce Taino warrior chieftain, Yuiza. The native Taino tribes played a major role in the history and culture of the island of Puerto Rico. At the head of each tribe was a chieftain or cacique who governed each of the yucayeques, or villages of the island; the only female cacique in the history of the Taino in Puerto Rico was a powerful leader, Yuiza. The Municipality of Loiza between the City of San Juan and El Yunque Rainforest is named after Yuiza and the historic road linking the two areas is affectionately known as Calle Loiza.

Art and culture form vital mediums for how Puerto Rico continues to define its diverse heritage and people that have blended together into a social harmony that continues to persevere and invite people onto the island in the face of severe economic and environmental hardship. Yuiza is meant to shine as a bright and powerful beacon representing the heart of the Puerto Rican people, a spirit that seductively causes visitors to become residents before they know it and a spirit that animates the experience into memories that last a lifetime.
